NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Approval of accepting Camas Creek Contracting bid for building of garage addition to the Cut Bank Police Department. Councilperson Maynard made a motion. Councilperson Reynolds seconded the motion.** Councilperson Nygaard asked if we were just accepting the base bid or were we just doing some of the alternatives. The Mayor stated that we were going to accept the base bid and alternative A for \$6,720. This alternative would make it so we could add a mezzanine later if we wanted. The Council accepted the bid with the alternative A. Councilperson Gibson asked if there was a plan to replenish the capital improvement fund. The Mayor stated that with getting higher interest and other things that we could replenish the money. Clerk/Treasurer Schultz stated that with the payment of the taxes for the Police Levy and the Permissive Health Levy from February that some of that money is due to the general fund so that could go into the capital improvement fund. **The Mayor called for a vote. The Council approved the contract 4-0.**
